Stefano F. Cappa received his M.D. at the University of Milano, where he completed his neurology training. He has held assistant professor and associate professor positions in Neurology and Neurological Rehabilitation at the University of Brescia, since 1999 Professor of Cognitive Neuroscience at the Vita Salute S. Raffaele University and Director of the Neurology Department of S. Raffaele Turro Hospital, Milano, Italy, from 2013 Professor and Director of the Biomedical Class at IUSS Pavia; from 2017 to 2019 Scientific Director of the IRCCS S. Giovanni di Dio Fatebenefratelli, Brescia. From 2019 Head of Dementia Clinical Research, IRCCS Mondino Foundation, Pavia. He has spent research periods at Boston University, at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, at University of California San Diego, at the Medical Research Council Cyclotron Unit of Hammersmith Hospital in London and at the Max Planck Institut for Cognitive Neuroscience in Leipzig. His main areas of expertise are language, memory and social cognition disorders, development and application of behavioral testing and advanced neuroimaging to neurodegenerative disorders. Former President of the Federation of European Neuropsychological Societies and the Italian Society of Neurology for the Study of Dementia (SINDEM). He has published more than 350 articles in specialized journals, several books and book chapters.
